EXAM INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

Dates of Exams:

23 September: DELF A2/B1

- 09:00am: EPREUVES COLLECTIVES A2/B1
- From 12 :50 pm : EPREUVES INDIVIDUELLES A2
- From 11:20 am: EPREUVES INDIVIDUELLES B1

24 September: DELF A1

- 09:00am: EPREUVES COLLECTIVES A1
- From 11:20 am: EPREUVES INDIVIDUELLES A1

On test day:

- Only the candidate will be allowed to enter the test venue.
- An identity check will be performed before you enter the exam premises by AF administrative staff and the examiners before each test. Candidates must show :
 - their **Examinations Summon (CONVOCAATION)**.
 - a **valid identity card (NIC/Postal ID/Passport)** with a clear picture of his/hers.
- The candidate should arrive at the examination venue **at least 30 minutes** before the start of the examination.
- The candidate number, timeslots and the room numbers for both written and oral examinations are given on the **Examinations Summon (CONVOCAATION)**. A copy can be handed over to the candidate during the identity check before the examination.
- **Check and confirm your details** (Name, birthplace, birthday) and inform if there is any change to the examiner during the written examination.
- For Written/Oral exams, Candidates' names will be displayed at the entrance of each classroom.

Important Notes:

- No candidate will be allowed in the exam room after the exam starting time.
- DELF Junior exam fees will not be refunded or transferred.
- DELF Junior **Attestations (Results' sheets)** will be available within 2 -3 weeks from the date of the exam.
- **The Original diploma certificates** will be available within approximately 3 months.
- We will inform Candidates ahead of the test date via SMS or Email of any changes in their test schedule and/or test venue.
